- The Superintendent provided Board members a packet of information entitled PYLUSD Knows the ABCs of College which details the a-e requirements for college entrance and the various courses available at district high schools that fulfill these requirements. Posters reflecting this information will be displayed at our district middle and high schools and the information will also be available on the district website.
- The Superintendent was pleased to announce that El Dorado High School's video production students had garnered a number of top awards at the recent Orange County Film Festival.
- On a similar note, the Superintendent was proud to share that 27% of the students selected to participate in the 2014 Southern California Honor Jazz Ensembles were PYLUSD students.

Bylaws of the Board

9230 - BB

COMPENSATION OF BOARD MEMBERS**Compensation**

In accordance with provisions of Education Code, Section 35120, each board member may be compensated in the amount of \$750.00 per month prorated for any meeting missed by a member.

On an annual basis, the Board may increase the compensation of Board members beyond the limit delineated in Education Code 35120 in an amount not to exceed five percent based on the present monthly rate of compensation. (Education Code 35120)

Any member who does not attend all meetings held in any month may receive, as compensation for his or her services, an amount not greater than \$750.00 divided by the number of meetings held and multiplied by the number of meetings actually attended.

A member may be paid for any meeting when absent if the board by resolution duly adopted and included in its minutes finds that at the time of the meeting he or she was performing services outside the meeting for the school district, was ill or on jury duty, or the absence was due to a hardship deemed acceptable by the board.

To provide guidance and a clear understanding of the definition of a hardship absence, the following parameters are established:

1. Illness/injury of an immediate family member.
2. Death of a member of the immediate family.
3. Official court appearance.
4. Pregnancy/miscarriage/childbirth in immediate family.
5. Hardship or any other circumstance presented to and approved by the board.

Any board member who so desires may elect in writing to receive compensation at a rate less than the maximum allowable. Said election by a board member must specify the amount the member elects to receive in lieu of the statutory maximum, and is subject to rescission at any time by the board member.

Student board members shall receive no compensation for meetings attended. (Education Code 35012)

The Board President shall exercise diligence in attempting to schedule any special meetings according to availability of all board members.

Reimbursement of Expenses

Any representative of the board, when performing services directed by the board, shall have his or her actual travel expenses paid by the district. Other expenses of board members for attendance at conventions and meetings of societies, associations and the like will be paid by the district when such attendance and payment of expenses has specifically been authorized by the board.

Errors and Omissions

The district shall also provide board members with defense and damage payments for errors and omissions or for alleged wrongful acts or omissions arising within the scope of district duties to the extent permitted by the California Education Code and California Government Code.

Bylaw 9230 shall be reviewed annually at the organizational meeting of the board.

SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

The Board of Education of the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District employs a professional school executive, the district superintendent of schools, to administer the schools, and evaluates and appraises his services.

The board is authorized by the Education Code to employ the superintendent of schools and such assistant superintendents as it deems necessary.

The superintendent shall be the chief executive officer and secretary to the board and shall exercise such powers and duties granted or imposed upon him by the Board or by law.

The superintendent shall generally hold valid credentials in both teaching and school administration, as shall such assistant superintendents whom the board employs other than in a business capacity exempted by law. The board may, however, waive any credential requirement on the part of the superintendent when it deems such waiver to be in the best interests of the district.

The superintendent, and such assistant superintendents as the board employs, may be given a four-year employment contract as provided in the Education Code and subject to renewal and termination procedures specified therein.
