**RESOLUTION NO. 2**

**RESOLUTION FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ACTING AS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1 AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING OF SPECIAL TAXES FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (the "Board") has heretofore taken proceedings pursuant to the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982, as amended, (the "Act") for the establishment of Community Facilities District No. 1 (the "District") for the purpose of providing educational facilities for the use of residents of the District; and

**WHEREAS**, following a special election of the qualified electors of the District, this Board on November 12, 2002 acting as the governing body of the District, adopted Ordinance No. 1 ("Ordinance") which provided for the levying and collection of Special Taxes within the District, "as provided in the Act and Ordinance and as approved by the qualified electors"; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary and appropriate that this Board levy and collect the Special Taxes for Fiscal Year 2019-2020, by the adoption of a resolution as specified by the Act and Ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. In accordance with the Act and Ordinance, there is hereby levied upon all properties within the District which are not otherwise exempt from taxation under the Act or Ordinance the special taxes for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 set forth in the Ordinance at the tax rates as set forth therein and in Exhibit "A" hereto, as may be amended without further action of the Board to reflect updated information on assessor's parcel numbers from the County of Orange. The Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, is hereby authorized and directed to establish the final rates to be levied, which final rates shall not exceed the maximum rates.

Section 2. The above-authorized special taxes shall be collected in the same manner as ad valorem property taxes on the secured roll by the Treasurer-Tax Collector of the County of Orange and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedure and sale in cases of delinquency as provided for such ad valorem taxes.

Section 3. The Clerk and Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, are hereby authorized to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Orange County Assessor and the Treasurer-Tax Collector, together with other supporting documentation as may be required in order to place said special taxes on the secured property tax roll for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 and to perform all other acts which are required by the Act, Ordinance, or by-law in order to accomplish the purpose of this Resolution.

**RESOLUTION NO. 3  
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PLACENTIA-YORBA LINDA UNIFIED SCHOOL  
DISTRICT GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT AN EASEMENT (RIGHT OF WAY) TO

**WHEREAS**, the Southern California Edison (“Utility Agency”) has requested that the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District (“School District”) dedicate an easement to Southern California Edison upon a portion of the School District’s Bernardo Yorba Middle School site (“Easement”). A legal description and map depicting the location of the Easement is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17556, the governing board of a school district may convey to any public corporation, or private corporation engaged in the public utility business, any real property belonging to such school district upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree;

**WHEREAS**, the School District desires to provide an Easement to Southern California Edison for public utility for electrical purposes to construct, reconstruct, install, replace, reconfigure, operate, maintain, repair, relocate, remove, inspect, observe, and study the equipment, and related appurtenances in, on, over, under, upon, above, along and across the land in the City of Yorba Linda on Bernardo Yorba Middle School;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must, prior to dedicating an Easement, adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate such Easement in a regular open meeting by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all of its members;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17557, the School District’s governing board must fix a time at its regular place of meeting for a public hearing upon the question of making the dedication of the Easement; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Education Code Section 17558, the School District is required to post copies of this Resolution, signed by the board, in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries not less than ten (10) days before the public hearing, and publish notice once, not less than five (5) days before the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the School District, if there is one, or, if there is no such newspaper published in the School District, then in a newspaper published in the county which has a general circulation in the School District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the above recitals are all true and correct.

**Section 2.** That the School District’s governing board (“Board”) declares its intent to dedicate the Easement to Southern California Edison upon the terms and conditions set forth in the recitals.

**Section 3.** That the Board establishes August 13, 2019 for a public hearing on the question of the School District’s intent to dedicate the Easement to Southern California Edison.

**Section 4.** The School District staff shall post this resolution in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries and publish notice of the adoption of this resolution in compliance with Education Code Section 17558.

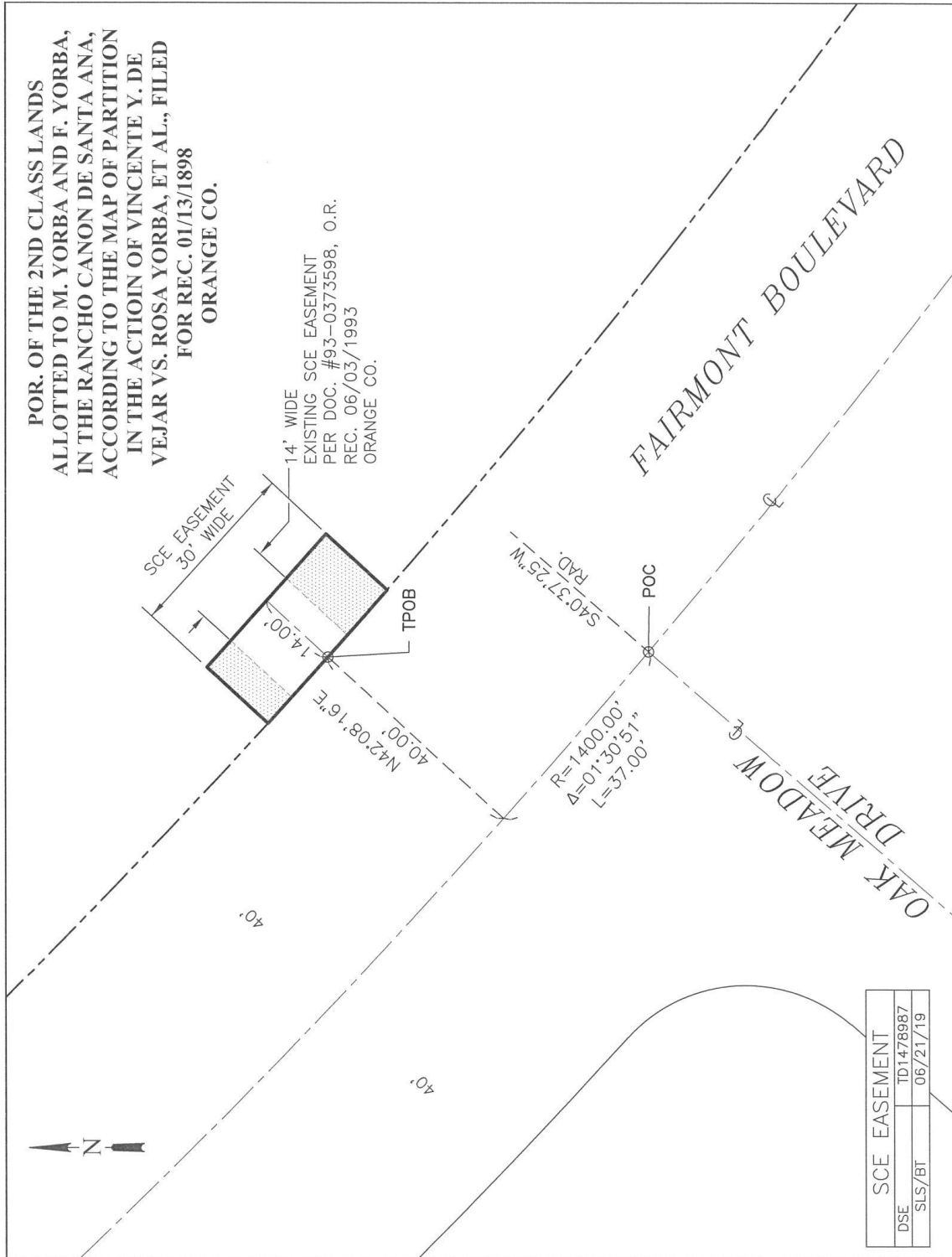
